Our Easter parties are:

Friday, April 14 (3s & 4s MWF and Pre-K am classes).***

We will dye eggs; have an Easter egg hunt; make a refrigerator magnet; and use play-dough to make the cross on the Hill of Calvary.

For the safety of our children, please do not leave your car running when you come into the building.

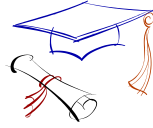
And please do not leave your other children in the car when you drop off and pick up your preschooler; either ask another parent to keep an eye on your child(ren) or come in and ask a staff member.

FUN THINGS TO DO WITH YOUR CHILD

ALPHABET RECOGNITION

- Point out letters in everyday environment (Ask “what are the letters on the stop sign?”)
- Alphabet refrigerator magnets
- Play a game with flash cards
- Reading books together – point to each word as you read it out loud

NUMBER RECOGNITION

- Identifying numbers on license plates (also good for letter recognition)
- Counting cooking ingredients (such as cups of flour)
- Playing card games (such as Go Fish or Memory Matching)
- Setting the table for meals (everyone needs one plate, one fork, one spoon, one knife, one napkin, one glass, etc.)

HANDWRITING

- Writing thank you notes
- Writing letters and notes to family and friends (it’s always fun to write a note (or draw a picture) and tuck it into a lunch box or briefcase or backpack)
- Writing in soap bubbles or in a box of sand (bathtub soap crayons are always fun)
