We need one-gallon milk/water jugs for our Easter baskets. Please bring them to school by March 15. Thank you.

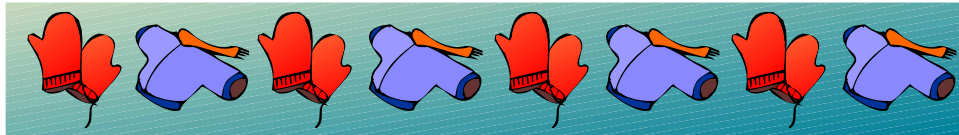


PRE-REGISTRATION FOR FALL
